






The club has several parades scheduled this fall as well. The club is working hard to grow and show our passion for helping children.








### MWB Tim Thomas Appointed Trustee

Masonic Biography Robert T. Thomas

Most Worshipful Brother Robert T. Thomas was born in Kissee Mills, Missouri on May 15, 1958. He graduated from Forsyth High School in 1976, where he served as Student Body President. He attended College of the Ozarks in Point Lookout Missouri. Tim spent his early years on the farm, where it became necessary to take over the duties of his father who passed away while MWB Thomas was a young teen. After leaving college, Tim was certified as a Stainless-Steel welder and was a member of the Sheet Metal Workers Union in Springfield, MO.

MWB Thomas served his country as a member of the Missouri National Guard from 1978-84 as a helicopter mechanic and crew chief. He continued his public service by becoming a member of the Missouri State Water Patrol in 1981. While at the Water Patrol, he specialized in evidence and crime scene investigations and was nationally recognized for his work as a boat accident Reconstructionist. He retired from the Missouri State



Highway Patrol in 2012 after 31 years of service to the citizens of the State of Missouri. After retirement, he was employed by the C.O.M.E.T. Drug Task Force as supervisor of their evidence unit. He continued his public service by serving as the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the College of the Ozarks Associates and President of the Crane R-III Board of Education. He and his wife served the Stone County Republican Central Committee as Lincoln Township chairpersons.

Tim and his wife Kathryn were married in 2002. They have two children, Andy, and Shelby. Tim and Kathryn are blessed with four grandchildren, Mabrey, Waylon, Julianna, and Lucy. The Thomas family resides in Crane, Missouri where they are very active members of the Crane First Baptist Church.

MWB Thomas is currently an endowed member of Solomon Lodge, #271 in Springfield, MO. He started his Masonic journey at Galena Lodge #515, where he was raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason in 1993 and served as Master of the Lodge in 1997. Tim served as the DDGM of the 43rd Masonic District in 2004 and 2005. He was appointed Grand Sword Bearer in 2009. Tim has served the Grand Lodge in many capacities while serving on numerous committees. MWB Thomas was appointed to the Advancing Line of The Grand Lodge of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of the State of Missouri by MWB Gail S. Turner in 2010. Tim is the Past President of the Masonic Children's Foundation and past Chairman of the Masonic Scholarship Selection Committee. He served as the President and later Honorary Chairman of the Masonic Home Board of Directors by virtue of his Grand Lodge position. Tim is an endowed member of the Missouri Lodge of Research. He is a member of the Order of the Past Master and the Sword of Bunker Hill.

MWB Thomas 33° is an endowed member of the Scottish Rite Valley of Joplin where he serves on the Class Committee. He was very active in the Knights of St. Andrew. He is a past Commander of the Joplin Council of Knights Kadosh. He served as assistant Class Committee Director as well as on Chairman of the Library Committee, assistant Chairman of the Scottish Rite Clubs and on the Membership Committee. MWB Thomas was invested with the rank of Knight Commander of the Court of Honor in 2005, and Coroneted a 33rd Degree Scottish Rite Mason in 2015.

MWB Thomas is an active member of Abou Ben Adhem Shrine in Springfield, Missouri where he participated for many years as a member of the ritual cast. He was a member of Keystone Kops and served as a member of The Shrine Bats for over 20 years. He is also a life member of the Taney County Shrine Club.

Tim is a former member of Kimberling City Chapter #164 of the Order of Eastern Star along with his wife and daughter. He is a York Rite Mason and a member of Springfield Chapter #15 Royal Arch Masons, and former member of Zabud Council #25 Royal and Select Masters, and St. John's Commandery #20 KT. He is an active member of St. Christopher Conclave Red Cross of Constantine. In 2019, MWB Thomas became a member of Ozark Council #240 Allied Masonic Degrees. He was also made a member of Ray V. Denslow York Rite College #180 and Cell Airne Council #76 Knight Masons of the U.S.A. He is also a member of Springfield Chapter #84 of the National Sojourners Inc.

MWB Thomas is a strong supporter of Masonic Youth and has served on the advisory board of Taneycomo Assembly #100 International Order of the Rainbow for Girls. In 2019 he was awarded Honorary membership to the International Supreme Council of the Order of Demolay and was also invested with the Honorary Legion of Honor.



## My FezCard Viewer

The new My FezCard Viewer app provides members with immediate access to their digital membership card on their smartphone without the need to carry a hard card in their wallet. Additional benefits of the My FezCard Viewer include a unique QR code function that permits members to check in at their Shrine Center/Club/Unit, earn award points, enter raffle drawings, and more!



The My FezCard Viewer is available for download on the Apple App Store or on Google Play.

### Currently, there are three methods to access a digital membership card:

- 1) At ShrinersInternational.org, members may log into the Member Center and click "View Member Card." Once showing on their screen, they may take a screen shot of their current card and retain it in their photo gallery for future use. \*Note, this is a static image, and will not update following the 2023 renewal cycle.
- 2) At WebFez.ShrineNet.org, members may log into their member profile and click "View Shrine Card." Likewise, a screenshot and static image may be retained for future use.
- 3) **NEW: Launched at Session**, members may visit their app store (Google Play Store or Apple App Store) and download "My FezCard Viewer." They will be prompted to register (once) using their Shrine ID, last name and Temple name. This will populate a dynamic, live membership card which will update when new payments are posted to their WebFez account by the temples each year. Likewise, a swipe will reveal a QR code which can be utilized for scanning purposes (for attendance, award points, etc.).
